ORDER
(Hybrid Mode)

1. This is an application filed by the Applicant / Financial Creditor under Section 95(1) of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 for initiation of Insolvency Resolution Process in terms of in terms of Rule 7(2) of the Insolvency and Bankruptcy (Application to Adjudicating Authority for Insolvency Resolution Process for Personal Guarantors to Corporate Debtor) Rules, 2019 against the Respondent/Personal Guarantor of corporate debtor. Learned Counsel for the Applicant / Financial Creditor submitted that an advance copy has already been served upon the Respondent / Personal Guarantor as well as Corporate Debtor.
2. Heard, Learned Counsel for the Applicant / Financial Creditor and perused the records.
3. Learned Counsel for the Applicant / Financial Creditor has proposed **Mr. Manish Jain, having registration number IBBI/IPA-001/IP-P00874/2017-2018/11472** as IRP. A perusal of the IBBI site reveals that the AFA of the said IRP is valid till 30.06.2025.

4. We hereby appoint **Mr. Manish Jain, having registration number IBBI/IPA-001/IP-P00874/2017-2018/11472** as IRP in respect of the Respondent / Personal Guarantor with direction to submit the report under Section 99 of the IBC Code, 2016 within ten days.
5. The IRP is required to examine the Application as set out in Section 97(6) of IBC, 2016 and after examining the Application, as per Section 97(7) of the IBC, 2016 the IRP may recommend for the acceptance or rejection of the Application in his report, within a period of 10 days as contemplated under Section 99(1) of the IBC, 2016.
6. Let report be filed through separate IA in this matter by the IRP after serving the same on the Respondent / Personal Guarantor as well as Corporate Debtor.
7. All challenges to the present application, if any, to be taken up at the time, when necessary, order under Section 100 of the IBC Code, 2016 is to be passed by this Tribunal.
8. Let copy of this order as well as the petition be served upon the IRP for preparing the Report under Section 99 of IBC, 2016 by the Applicant / Financial Creditor within three days.
9. Accordingly, **C.P.(IB)/193(AHM)2024** is ordered.
