

“GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS”

It has been observed by the Hon'ble Bench(es) that parties, instead of filing mere clarificatory Memos, are filing Memos containing averments touching upon the pleadings of the case, seeking substantive reliefs, raising questions of Law, or introducing additional facts/documents requiring replies/counters from the opposite parties. Such practice is resulting in unnecessary prolongation and delay in adjudication of matters.

It has also been observed that urgent hearing/advance hearing applications are, at times, being listed along with the concerned main Company Petition (CP) or other Interlocutory Applications (IAs), thereby defeating the very purpose of filing separate urgent hearing/advance hearing applications.

Therefore, in order to ensure procedural discipline and expeditious disposal of cases, the following directions are issued:

1. All parties/Advocates/PCs are directed not to file Memos containing pleadings, additional facts, legal submissions, documents, or prayers seeking substantive reliefs having a bearing on the merits of the matter.
2. Any plea requiring amendment/supplementation of pleadings, adjudication on questions of Law, consideration of additional facts/documents, or necessitating any reply/counter from the opposite party shall be raised only by way of an appropriate Interlocutory Application (IA), duly supported by pleadings and affidavit, wherever required under Law.
3. Memos shall be confined only to clerical, procedural, administrative, or purely clarificatory aspects which neither affect the pleadings nor require any reply/counter from the opposite party or adjudication by the Hon'ble Bench. Filing of Memos shall not confer any right upon a party to treat the contents thereof as part of the pleadings unless specifically permitted by the Hon'ble Bench.
4. Any Memo found to be in the nature of pleadings or seeking substantive relief may not be entertained/listed by the Registry and may be returned under objections, with liberty to the party concerned to file an appropriate IA in accordance with Law. The Hon'ble Bench may also pass appropriate directions in this regard.
5. It is further directed that filing of urgent hearing/advance hearing IAs shall not be accompanied by substantive IAs seeking other reliefs. Only the urgent hearing/advance hearing IA shall be listed for consideration and placed before the Hon'ble Bench. The main CP/IA or any other substantive application shall not be listed along with such urgent hearing/advance hearing IA unless specifically directed by the Hon'ble Bench.
6. Upon allowing such urgent hearing/advance hearing IA, the matter may be advanced to a nearer date, as may be directed by the Hon'ble Bench, and shall not ordinarily be taken up for final hearing on the same day.

These instructions shall come into force with immediate effect.
