7. Standard Court Slips and Procedure

- (i) The standard formats of the Mentioning Slip, Adjournment Slip and Appearance Slip are appended as **Annexures IV, V and VI** respectively. All the benches will strictly adhere to the prescribed formats in order to ensure uniformity in practice and procedure.
- (ii) Any party seeking urgent mentioning of a matter before the Hon'ble Bench shall submit a Mentioning Slip in the prescribed format to the Court Master before commencement of the Court or at such time as may be permitted by the Hon'ble Bench. The Court Master shall place the same before the Hon'ble Bench for appropriate orders and, where the request is allowed, shall forward the endorsed slip to the Registry for taking necessary action.
- (iii) Any request for adjournment shall be made through an Adjournment Slip in the prescribed format. Where an adjournment is sought prior to the date of hearing, the request shall be addressed to the Designated Registrar of the concerned Bench, with a copy marked to the Respondent(s) or their learned Counsel/Authorised Representative(s) and the concerned Court Master. Such request shall ordinarily be submitted through e-mail or such other mode as may be prescribed, so as to reach the Registry not later than 2:00 p.m. on the working day preceding the date of hearing. The Court Master shall place the request before the Hon'ble Bench for appropriate orders, obtain the necessary directions of the Hon'ble Bench thereon, and ensure prompt compliance with such directions.
- (iv) Learned Counsel/Authorised Representatives appearing in any matter may mark their appearance by submitting an Appearance Slip in the prescribed format before the Court Master. The Appearance Slip shall form part of the Court record for the purpose of recording appearances. The Court Master shall ensure that the prescribed Appearance Slips are made readily available in the Court.
- (v) In cases where appearance is made through Video Conferencing, the learned Counsel/Authorised Representative may submit the duly filled Appearance Slip through the electronic mode notified in the Cause List by the concerned Court Master, before or during the course of the hearing.
- (vi) Nothing contained in this paragraph shall restrict the powers of the Hon'ble Bench to permit oral mentioning, entertain oral requests for adjournment, or adopt such other procedure as may be considered appropriate in the interest of justice.

1.	The Registry is committed to the expeditious scrutiny of all pending matters on a priority basis, according to their period of pendency.
2.	The role of the Registry is an administrative only and does not extend to provide any legal advice on pending cases.
3.	Company Petitions filed under Sections 241, 242, and 244 of the Companies Act, once numbered, will be listed on the next working Thursday . a. All other Company Petitions, once numbered, will be listed within two working days (subject to the roster of the Hon'ble Bench) b. Interlocutory Applications, once numbered, will be listed on the next working day , irrespective of the listing date of the connected main Petition. (subject to the roster of the Hon'ble Bench)
4.	Certified or free copies of orders will, as far as possible, be issued to the concerned Advocates/PCS within two working days , subject to staff availability and depending on volumes of pages.
5.	Orders in reserved matters, after pronouncement, will be uploaded in the DMS portal of the NCLT on the same day or the next working day.
6.	Additional documents or pleadings filed without the permission of the Hon'ble Bench will not be accepted by the Registry.
7.	Once a matter is reserved for orders, no further pleadings shall be accepted, unless liberty is specifically granted by the Hon'ble Bench.
8.	All additional documents such as Counters, affidavits, memos, and proof of service etc., are to be filed along with a copy of the order, wherein the Hon'ble Bench has directed to file the same.
9.	Any Additional documents such as Memos, Affidavits, Proof of Service, written arguments and counters etc., are required to be e-filed, while serving on the opposite party at least three days prior to the listing date of the concerned matter . Late filings will not be accepted by the Registry. Hard copies of all additional documents are required to be submitted to the Registry at least two days prior to the listing date of the matter . Late submissions will not be accepted by the Registry.

10.	All defects notified must be rectified <i>in a single instance</i> within the prescribed time frame.
11.	The Inward Filing Counter of the Registry shall be open on all working days from 10.30 AM to 5.00 P.M.
12.	All Counsels, PCS, IRPs/RPs, Liquidators, and BTs shall indicate their respective case item numbers from the causelist along with their WebEx login names. They must mark their attendance either through the WebEx Chat Box or in the physical attendance register maintained in the Court Hall.
13.	Proxy counsels appearing on behalf of Counsel on Record / Senior Counsel have to clearly indicate their Name, Bar Council Registration Number, Contact Number and the CP / IA number for which they are representing, along with the name of the counsel for whom they are appearing . This information has to be recorded either in the WeBex Chat Box (for virtual hearings) or in the Attendance Register maintained in Court Hall(for physical hearings). <i>Submissions before the Hon'ble Bench will be permitted only upon proper record of attendance.</i>
14.	All Insolvency Resolution Professionals (IRPs), Resolution Professionals (RPs), Liquidators and Bankruptcy Trustees are required to file a fresh ' Vakalatnama with stamped ' in every Interlocutory Application. In the absence of fresh Vakalatnama in Interlocutory Application, the IRP/RP/ Liquidator/BT concerned has to represent in person before the Hon'ble Bench.
15.	No Counsels or their representatives, PCS, IRPs/RPs, Liquidators, or BTs are allowed to inquire about the status of scrutiny or compliance of defects over phone. All Counsels, Parties, PCS, IRPs/RPs, Liquidators, and BTs must appear physically at the Registry to comply with the defects.
16.	The Registry is strictly prevented from engaging in mobile correspondence with Counsels, Litigants, or Parties regarding the status of pending case scrutiny. All communications must be conducted in person or through official channels.
