31 out of 88 govt senior secondary schools sans principal in Muktsar

MUKTSAR, DECEMBER 7
As many as 31 government senior secondary schools are operating without regular principals in Muktsar district. The district has total of 88 government senior secondary schools.

The additional charge of principal in these schools has been given to the principals of neighbouring schools. Presently, Education Department officials are awaiting promotion of some teachers as principal.

A schoolteacher said that since the principal is the head of the school, this post should not be left vacant. "In the absence of a regular principal, the staff becomes negligent. Further, if a teacher is given the additional charge of principal, he/she can't perform like a regular principal. It also affects the teaching work of that teacher," said a government schoolteacher.

On this, Jaspal Monga, District Education Officer, Muktsar, said, "Posts of principal are vacant in 31 government senior secondary schools, but

the posts of heads in all primary, middle and high schools are filled. Further, the state government will fill vacancies soon by appointing more teachers and promoting the existing staff."

Former AAP MLA Phoolka to join SAD

Announce MSP, debt waiver at earliest: Farm unions to Centre

Members of several farm unions today burnt effigies of the Centre at nine locations in Bathinda district against lobbying of tear gas shells on peaceful farmers marching towards Delhi from the Shambhu border yesterday.

The farmers held dharnas at Rampura, Bhagat, Kothaguru, Jandawala, Sardargarh, Sangat, Talwandi Sabo, Nathana and Maur.

Farm leader Shingara Singh Mann said the farmers had been struggling for justice and rights related to the rising debt and the government's neglect of their concerns.

They also criticised the Haryana Government's

actions, stating that farmers were being treated as though they were outsiders in their own country and sought immediate action to address the legitimate demands of the farmers, including debt waiver, and

PM adding insult to injury: Farmers

Activists of the Samyukt Kisan Morcha (Non-political) organised dharnas at several places in Malerkotla district to protest against the inhuman treatment meted out to the farmers at the Shambhu border yesterday by the Haryana Police.

The protesters burnt an effigy of the NDA government led by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

The protesters led by Rajinder Singh Bhogival of the Bharti Kisan Union (Ugrahan) organised dharnas in Malerkotla, Amargarh and Ahmedgarh subdivisions.

Speakers alleged that the NDA government led by Prime Minister Narendra Modi was adding insult to injury by not fulfilling the promises he had made during the withdrawal of 2021 stir.

The protesters said the ensuing protest does not relate with interests of farmers only,

rather its outcome would affect all sections of society, including daily wagers, small traders and employees.

"We once again wish to apprise you that the ensuing protests are not only concerned with demands of farmers. Rather, we are fighting for the interests of all sections of society. Unfortunately, the BJP has once again committed a cowardly act by using Haryana cops to cane-charge the farmers heading towards Delhi on foot," said Bhogival.

2 groups clash at Kapurthala jail, four injured; old rivalry, say police

A clash broke out between two groups of convicts at the Kapurthala Central Jail yesterday night, leaving four inmates injured.

The injured have been identified as Simranjeet Singh of Amritsar, Vishal and Sunil from Lambra in Jalandhar and Mukesh from Rama Mandi in Jalandhar.

son behind the clash. Simranjeet, who was critically injured in the clash, has been referred to the Amritsar Medical College Amritsar.

While another injured inmate is undergoing treatment at the Kapurthala Civil Hospital, the remaining two inmates were sent back to the jail after administering first

aid. Kapurthala SP (Investigations) Sarabjit Rai said, "The men do not belong to any notable gang. They had an old rivalry with each other due to which the clash broke out. The injuries were inflicted through iron bars. Simranjeet is under treatment at the Amritsar Medical College. He is out of danger."
