

MBBS exam scam: 3 papers 'leaked' to facilitate racketeers

Invigilator charged ₹30K per paper; mastermind took ₹3L

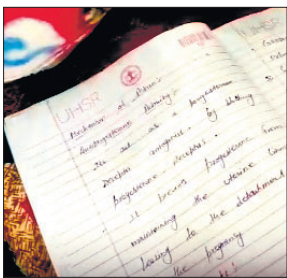

The MBBS examination scam at Pt BD Sharma University of Health Sciences, Rohtak (UHSR), appears to be more deeply entrenched than initially suspected. Fresh revelations indicate that question papers were leaked on at least three occasions in 2024 to facilitate a meticulously organised answer-sheet racket, allegedly run by a nexus of insiders and students.

As per sources, this revelation was made during the interrogation of a key accused. The accused revealed that question papers for exams held on May 15, 17, and 19 were leaked by an invigilator, who clicked images of the papers and shared them with accomplices via mobile phone.

These images were further circulated on WhatsApp to MBBS students from other batches. These students, in turn, were assigned the task of rewriting the answer



sheets for the original examinees. "On all three days, these students completed the answer sheets at the residence of the accused. Two of them wrote six answer sheets each, impersonating different candidates. Another student completed four, while a fourth wrote three," an official said on condition of anonymity.

The forged answer sheets were then allegedly swapped with the originals in the university's secrecy branch, with help from insiders.

Investigations further revealed that blank answer sheets were sourced by an assistant-level UHSR employee recruited through the Haryana Kaushal Roz-

gar Nigam. The invigilator who leaked the papers reportedly charged Rs 30,000 per paper. The main accused charged Rs 3 lakh per subject from students, covering the entire process of writing and submitting the fake answer sheets.

"Surprisingly, no action has yet been taken against the invigilator, despite his name being mentioned during police interrogation. Additionally, several other officials have also been named by the accused, but they are yet to be questioned in connection with the scam," said the source.

A senior UHSR official, also requesting anonymity, said: "As the case is under police investigation, any disciplinary action will depend on the findings. We will act strictly if arrests are made and concrete evidence is produced. Already, two regular employees and several outsourced staff members have been terminated in connection with this case."

Chargesheet filed; 17 mobile numbers under scrutiny

The Rohtak police have filed a comprehensive 978-page chargesheet in connection with the MBBS exam scam at Pt BD Sharma University of Health Sciences (UHSR). Three university employees — Roshan Lal, Rohit and Deepak — have been named in the chargesheet. All three were dismissed from service following the scandal and are currently in judicial custody.

"The chargesheet comprises 978 pages, while the probe is still underway," said DSP Dalip Singh, who is heading the investigation.

According to sources, 187 pages of the chargesheet detail the examination records of 24 MBBS students from a private medical college who were booked in February for their alleged involvement in the scam. These documents were furnished by UHSR authorities.

As part of the ongoing investigation, the police have identified 17 suspicious mobile numbers reportedly used during the execution of the scam. Authorities are currently retrieving Call Detail Records (CDRs), Customer Application Form (CAF)

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One of the accused, during police remand, pointed investigators to a toilet beneath the secrecy branch of the university, which was allegedly used as a secret location for exchanging tampered answer sheets.

The chargesheet also documents the seizure of Rs 6 lakh from one accused's residence, two mobile phones suspected to have been used by an invigilator to leak exam papers, and a machine employed to stitch answer sheets after tampering. The scam involved the illicit removal of answer sheets during annual and supplementary MBBS exams. These were re-attempted by students and stealthily re-submitted to the secrecy branch to fraudulently obtain passing marks.

HC paves way for resumption of trial against Hooda

CHANDIGARH, MAY 15

The Punjab and Haryana High Court today dismissed petitions challenging the trial proceedings in the Manesar land case. The decision paves way for the resumption of the trial against Bhupinder Singh Hooda, a former CM, and senior bureaucrats who served in his office.

The stay on trial, in effect since December 2020 following petitions filed by some former bureaucrats and builders, also stands vacated, with Justice Manjari Nehru Kaul dismissing the petitions. The copy of the detailed judgment

is not yet available.

The CBI, which is prosecuting the case, had moved the high court, seeking vacation of the stay imposed on the trial. Hooda had not approached the court, but the stay granted in the matter had benefited his case.

In its chargesheet filed in February 2018, the CBI had named Hooda, along with 33 others, including three for-

mer bureaucrats who served as his Principal Secretaries, besides officials from the Town and Country Planning Department and representatives of several real estate companies.

The agency alleged that nearly 400 acres were acquired from farmers in Manesar and adjoining villages in Gurugram district on the pretext of "public purpose", but were later licensed to builders and developers at undervalued rates. This, according to the CBI, caused a loss of about Rs 1,500 crore to the farmers. — TNS

Pakistani spy was getting ₹5,000 per photo, video

ISI handler had migrated to Pakistan from UP

Noman Ilahi, who was arrested by the police for allegedly spying for terror organisations, was in direct contact with Iqbal Kana, an ISI handler in Pakistan. The police are also investigating his links at Kairana, Uttar Pradesh, and also got details of some persons who were reportedly in touch with him.

As per sources, Ilahi had been working as a passport agent at Kairana for a long time, and processed applications of people wishing to visit Islamic countries, including Pakistan. This is where he came in contact with Kana.

The sources said Kana also hailed from Kairana, but had left the country around 30 years ago to settle in Pakistan.

They said the Delhi police had seized 75 pistols, reportedly sent from Pakistan to Delhi, and Kana's name also came up in the smuggling of weapons. He has been running anti-India activities from Pakistan.

He used to come in contact with people living at Kairana and searched for youths to work with him.

The sources claimed that Ilahi was getting good money from Pakistani handlers and he was also

in contact with some other people in Pakistan. He used to send them sensitive information, especially the movement of the Army in trains.

He came to Panipat four-five months ago to live with his sister in Hali Colony and joined a job of security guard at a blanket factory. But, he often used to skip work and go to railway stations to make videos of Army trains or their movement. Police sources said he was getting Rs 4,000 to Rs 5,000 per photo and video, and he used to send them regularly to Pakistan.

The police also raided a public service centre at Kairana and identified some people who were reportedly in contact with Ilahi.

Investigation agencies are also scrutinising the passport applications processed by Ilahi.

SIT appointed by SC begins probe in Bhatla social boycott case

HISAR, MAY 15

A Special Investigation Team (SIT), comprising two retired Directors General of Police (DGPs), has begun a fresh probe into an eight-year-old case involving the alleged social boycott of members of the Scheduled Caste (SC) community by upper-caste residents in Bhatla village of Hisar district.

Formed on the directions of the Supreme Court, the four-member team includes retired DGPs Kamalendra Prasad and VC Goel, along with two retired Deputy Superintendents of Police (DSPs). The team arrived in the Hansi police district to initiate the reinvestigation.

Police sources confirmed that some members of the SIT visited Bhatla village on Wednesday to begin their inquiry. Several villagers were also summoned to Hansi town in connection with the case. While the SIT did not engage with mediapersons, they held discussions with local police and administrative officials to brief them on the investigation.

Advocate Rajat Kalsan, who has been pursuing the case, said, "The Supreme Court had constituted this Special Investigation Team (SIT) on October 16, following a hearing
