79.8% students pass state board Class X exam, Girls grab top 4 ranks

DHARAMSALA, MAY 15 Saina Thakur of Neugal Model Public Senior Secondary School at Bhawarna in Kangra district topped the Class X examination, the results of which were declared by the Himachal Pradesh School Education Board today. Saina scored 696 out of 700 marks (99.43 per cent).

Ridima Sharma, RK Senior Secondary Public School at Ghandalwin in Bhoranj tehsil of Hamirpur district got the second position by scoring 695 marks (99.29 per cent), just one mark less than Saina's. Two girls jointly held the third place by scoring 694 marks each (99.14 per cent). Mudita Sharma of Modern Public Senior Secondary School, Swarghat, shared the third place with Parnika Sharma of Minerva Senior

Secondary School, Ghumarwin in Bilaspur district. In this year's Class X results, the girl students outperformed the boys, as there were 15 girls among the 17 students who secured the top five ranks. Of the total 95,495 candidates, who had appeared in

the exam, 75,862 (79.8 per cent) were declared pass while 427 had abstained. Of 48,946 male students, who had appeared in the Class X examination, 38,002 (77.6 per cent) were declared pass while 37,860 (82 per cent) of total 46,122 girl students, who had appeared in the Class X

exam, were declared pass. Hemraj Bairwa, Chairman of the education board, said that the pass percentage of the Class X exam this year was 79.8 per cent, a rise of 5.2 per cent compared to 74.6 per cent last year. He highlighted the digital means the board had employed for conducting the exam.

Ban Turkey apple, state growers request Goyal

SHIMLA, MAY 15 A delegation of apple growers met Union Minister for Commerce and Industry Piyush Goyal today and urge him to ban the import of fruit from Turkey. The delegation, under the banner of the Himalayan Apple Growers Society, expressed deep concern over the rapidly increasing apple import from Turkey and wanted an immediate ban. The delegation handed over a memorandum to the minister and said that due to the cheap and subsidised imports, the local orchardists were incurring huge losses and were struggling to recover even the input costs. The delegation also

stressed the fact that Turkey provided military support and defence equipment to Pakistan in the recent conflict. "Import from such a country is not only harmful for the country's economy but is also worrying from the national security point of view," it added. The delegation pointed out that apple was not just a crop but also the backbone of the economy of the hill state and the livelihood of millions of horticulturalists. Besides a ban on import from Turkey, the delegation also demanded an increase in the minimum import price and strict enforcement of quality and phytosanitary standards so that any diseases or virus do not enter our country through apple.

State to receive rain from today

SHIMLA, MAY 15 Himachal is set to receive rainfall from tomorrow. The state Meteorological Department has issued a yellow weather warning for several districts for May 18 and 19. As per the forecast, light rainfall will occur in middle and high hills of the state tomorrow and only in low hills on May 17 and 18. Rainfall will occur across the state from May 19 to May 21. A yellow alert has been issued for Chamba and Kangra for May 18 and for Shimla, Solan, Mandi, Sirmour, Kinnaur, Bilaspur and Lahaul and Spiti on May 19, resulting in thunderstorms accompanied by lightning and gusty winds in these districts. Light rain occurred in several areas of the state during the past 24 hours while the weather was mostly dry. — TNS

SHIMLA, MAY 15 Health Minister Dhani Ram Shandil today directed the officials concerned to ensure total transparency in the purchase of world-class healthcare machinery and other medical equipment so that the people of the state could be provided the best services. Shandil presided over a meeting of the Special High-Powered Purchase Committee here. The committee gave approval for the purchase of five Phaco machines at an estimated cost of around Rs 30 lakh. It also approved amendments for expediting the process of procuring digital radiography machine, high-resolution colour doppler ultrasound and a digital mammography machine for Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru Government Medical College, Chamba. The committee also approved the recommendations of the Cabinet Technical Sub-Committee for the purchase of various machinery and equipment for Adarsh

5 PHACO MACHINES TO BE ACQUIRED

The Special High-Powered Purchase Committee gave approval for the purchase of five Phaco machines at an estimated cost of around ₹30 lakh Swasthya Sansthans. The minister said, "The government is tirelessly working to provide quality health infrastructure and services through Adarsh Swasthya Sansthans set up in around 50 Assembly constituencies of the state having six specialist doctors in each institution." He said that Adarsh Sewa Sansthans would be set up in all 68 Assembly constituencies in a phased manner. "The purchase of modern medical equipment is underway to strengthen healthcare institutions in Himachal Pradesh. Once equipped with adequate and latest modern machinery, these institutions will be able to provide quality treatment to people near their homes," he added.

No transfers in Education Dept after this month

SHIMLA, MAY 15 Education Minister Rohit Thakur today said that transfers in the Education Department would stop at the end of this month. The government has stopped round-the-year transfers in the department and are done only at the start of the academic session so that the studies of the students are not hampered. The minister said, "I am in favour of a proper transfer policy in the state. Many states have adopted a policy and we will adopt one in Himachal sooner or later." He added that the services of 778 part-time water carriers working in the Education Department, who had completed 11 years in job as on March 31, had been regularised against vacant Class-IV posts. He said that the govern-

ment was filling vacant posts and had sanctioned 15,000 posts of teacher, including 3,900 in the Primary Education Department. Additional 3,100 posts would soon be filled through the HP Rajya Chayan Aayog. To strengthen pre-primary education, 6,200 nursery teachers were being appointed, he added. The minister said that 1,200 schools were closed in the state in the past two and a half years. Among these were 450 schools that had zero enrolments while others were merged because of low enrolment, he added. He reiterated that the parameter for merging schools, if enrolment was less than 25 from Class VI to XII, had been kept, and around 100 schools with zero enrolment would be denotified. — TNS
