PATNA: Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar, as part of his ongoing Pragati Yatra, visited Mehna village in the Sattar Kattaiya block of Saharsa district. He was warmly welcomed with floral bouquets by Sadar BJP MLA Dr. Alok Ranjan and other dignitaries. During his visit, the Chief Minister inaugurated the +2 High School in the Mehna campus, inspected departmental stalls, distributed benefits to beneficiaries, and reviewed a playground and waste processing unit. Additionally, he laid the foundation stone and inaugurated 52 projects remotely and sur-



veyed the land identified for a government medical college and hospital. As part of the Pragati Yatra, the Chief Minister inaugurated a school approved for students from backward and extremely backward classes in the Mehna area. He also visited stalls set up by Jeevika Didis (self-help groups). Notable attendees included
