DC Vikram Singh chairs Review Meeting on Identified Criminal Cases

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FARIDABAD: Deputy Commissioner (DC) Vikram Singh has emphasized that investigations into cases classified under identified crimes in Faridabad district should be conducted thoroughly. He has instructed that detailed reports should be prepared by the police department. DC Vikram Singh was addressing police officers on Thursday, while presiding over a review meeting on identified crimes in the conference hall of the Mini Secretariat. The DC directed the police officials to ensure that they conduct a detailed investigation into sensational cases and prepare comprehensive reports before presenting them in court. He said that all accused should



be presented through video conferencing, which would save time and help resolve the cases. He made it clear that no accused should be physically brought to court for hearings; instead, video conferencing should be uti-

lized for this purpose. The DC also instructed the police to work towards ensuring the timely resolution of all identified cases within a time-frame. He emphasized the use of e-summons in such cases to bring transparency to the

judicial process. Highlighting specific crimes, DC Vikram Singh mentioned that cases under the POCSO Act, NDPS (commercial), rape, murder, MTP Act, and PC Act (corruption) fall under the category of identified crimes.

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He directed that these cases be investigated meticulously and presented in court with strong evidence. He added that no criminal should escape due to weak case preparation. The authenticity and strength of evidence and facts must be ensured before court hearings. The review meeting was attended by district legal officers, police department officials, and representatives from other concerned departments.

Noida Authority sells 4 commercial plots to leading realtors for Rs 1,500 crore

NOIDA: The Noida Authority has announced that it has sold four commercial plots to different realtors, generating a revenue of Rs 1,500 crore. One of the four plots is a small plot in Sector 50, while other three are bigger plots in other areas of the city and are already developed. The bidding process for these plots was held online on January 21 and 22, said authority officials. The Noida Authority had launched the plot scheme on September 9 and December 5 last year with eight large plots (20,000 square metres or more) on sale. The authority also launched a scheme for smaller sized plots in which all plots had an area of less than 20,000 square metres. This scheme was launched between November 30 and January 1. Noida Authority's chief executive officer (CEO), Lokesh M said that the authority shortlisted the firms that placed the highest bid against the reserve price during the e-bidding process.

He added that the allotment letter will be issued shortly after all the formalities are completed. Realtors in race The Noida Authority allots these commercial properties via a competitive online bidding process to the applicant makes the highest bid. During the bidding, 41,835.46 square metres plot in Sector 105 were allotted to realty firm Max Estate Limited, 24,000 square metres plot in Sector 98 was allotted to Manglam Multiplex Private Limited, 23,570.92 square metres plot in Sector 97 was allotted to M3M India Private Limited, and 812.73 square metre plot was allotted .
