Developed according to modern standards, the upgraded road will ensure smoother, safer, and faster transportation, benefiting industries, employees, logistics operations, and local residents in the rapidly growing region.

Bharat Taxi has partnered with Delhi Capitals as the official mobility partner for the 2026 T20 cricket season. The partnership focuses on providing convenient and reliable transportation for cricket fans during match days across Delhi NCR. Bharat Taxi CEO Himanshu Sharma said Delhi is a key market for the company and the collaboration will help address increased travel demand during the tournament. Sunil Gupta stated that the partnership would enhance the overall fan experience by ensuring smooth travel arrangements. Bharat Taxi will also run digital campaigns, on-ground activations and fan engagement initiatives throughout the season. The company currently operates with a network of over 3.76 lakh registered drivers across multiple cities.

Petronet LNG Limited reported strong financial performance for the quarter ended March 31, 2026, with its Dahej LNG Terminal processing 201 TBTU of LNG, compared to 189 TBTU in the corresponding quarter last year. The company achieved overall LNG processing of 219 TBTU during the quarter despite challenges arising from the Gulf region crisis. Capacity utilisation at the Dahej terminal stood at 90.1%. The company posted its highest-ever quarterly profit, reporting Profit Before Tax (PBT) of Rs. 1,795 crore and Profit After Tax (PAT) of Rs. 1,338 crore. For FY 2025-26, Petronet LNG recorded PBT of Rs. 1,518 crore and PAT of Rs. 3,843 crore. The Board of Directors has recommended a final dividend of Rs. 3 per share, citing operational efficiency and strong financial performance.

The Naitinal Bank Limited reported a strong financial performance for FY 2025-26, with operating profit rising 30.66% to Rs. 116.33 crore and net profit increasing 24.98% to Rs. 63.24 crore. The bank's total business crossed Rs. 14,118 crore, reflecting a 6.75% growth over the previous year. Gross advances grew 10.55%, while retail advances registered an impressive 22.65% rise. The bank also achieved a significant improvement in asset quality, with Gross NPA declining to 4.95% from 7.78% and Net NPA reducing sharply to 0.27%. The Provision Coverage Ratio improved to 94.01%. The bank reaffirmed its commitment to customer-centric growth through innovation and technology adoption.

RailTel Corporation of India Ltd. reported strong financial performance in the fourth quarter of FY 2025-26, recording an operating income of Rs. 1,669 crore, marking an 83% sequential growth over Q3. Both sides agreed to continue structured engagement for future maritime collaboration and technology partnerships.

Launching annual sales data of Organisation Internationale des Constructeurs d'Automobiles, he noted that global vehicle production increased from 92.7 million units in 2024 to 96.4 million in 2025, while sales rose to 99.8 million units. Asia-Oceania recorded strong growth, whereas Europe and the Americas witnessed declines in automobile production during 2025.

The unit began commercial operations on May 8, 2026, adding 250 MW of clean energy to the national grid. With this achievement, the project's total operational capacity has reached 1000 MW out of the planned 2000 MW.
