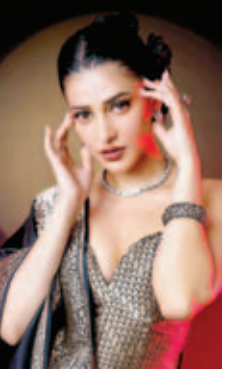


‘Sharing screen space with Rajini Sir was a full-circle moment’

As the walls of Nevermore widen, Netflix's 'Wednesday' grows more ambitious and somewhat more distracted. 'Season 2' isn't content with simply solving another murder mystery. Instead, it builds a deeper mythology, one that tangles the Addams legacy into a larger, older web of secrets.

However, in broadening its scope, the show embraces a risk by occasionally excluding the very character who contributed to its success.

This chapter begins with 'Wednesday's' return to Nevermore Academy, only to find the school under new leadership and the social order shaken. When a macabre incident disrupts student life, she finds herself drawn into a secret war between



ancient societies, one that appears to implicate her ancestors. This time, the puzzle is multi-layered, personal, and potentially deadly, with cryptic clues, recurring nightmares, and a new figure lurking in the shadows.

Jenna Ortega continues to carry the show with her unnervingly calm presence, though the scripts don’t always give her the space to shine. Catherine Zeta-Jones and Luis Guzmán more frequently step into the spotlight, which sometimes enriches the world but at other times interrupts it. The supporting cast, from curious classmates to sinister new arrivals, are lively but unevenly written, occasionally stealing time from the central thread.

Visually, the show remains stunning, all ornate gloom and dreamlike dread. Genre fans will appreciate the nods to classic horror, but what’s missing at times is that tight grip on character and mood that 'Season 1' managed so well.

'Part 1' wraps up just as the story starts to gain momentum. After a
