**NOTICE**  
(Under Rule 28 (3))

Attention of all concerned parties is invited to Rule 28(2) of NCLT Rules, 2016, which provides that on scrutiny, if an application is found to be defective, after notice to the party, the same shall be returned for compliance. If the defects are not removed within 7 (seven) days, the Registrar may pass appropriate orders.

2. On scrutiny of petitions and applications received by the Registry of this Bench under the Companies Act and the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016, certain cases are found to be defective as per objections raised and conveyed by the Scrutiny Section of the Bench which were to be removed/rectified within 7 days by the concerned parties.
