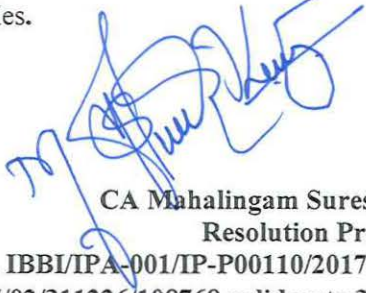

Parliament panel suggests revamp of bus transport sector, infra upgrade

COORDINATED TRAVEL. Calls for AAI-style bus terminal authority, easing permits, enabling nationwide ticket booking

A Parliamentary Standing Committee on Transport, Tourism and Culture has recommended replacing the All India Tourist Permit with a single All India Passenger Permit within one year, among a series of measures to revamp and upgrade the bus transport system.

Border stops, ₹1-1.5 lakh challans under an ambiguous tourist-permit regime, private buses being denied access to State-controlled terminals, passengers unable to seamlessly track or book services across operators and little dedicated infrastructure for a 4.4-lakh-bus market dominated by private ownership are among the problems a parliamentary panel hopes to fix through an overhaul of bus transport.

Transport operators told the committee that uncer-

tainty over permits could extend even to insurance claims after accidents, while industry representatives said 92 per cent of buses lacked supporting infrastructure.

The Sanjay Kumar Jha-led Parliamentary Standing Committee on Transport, Tourism and Culture has recommended ending the operation of bus border check posts still operating in six States — Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Nagaland, Arunachal Pradesh, Rajasthan and Punjab — and enforcement moved to Vahan, FASTag and vehicle-location data.

The proposed reset addresses a market in which three out of four buses are privately owned, but infrastructure and regulation remain heavily fragmented across the States.

The panel has sought a dedicated budgetary identity for bus infrastructure after industry representatives proposed that a proportion

“of the order of 25 per cent” of road allocation be directed towards public transport.

The Road Transport Ministry administers an annual budget of around ₹3 lakh crore, but the committee said there is no substantial provision specifically for bus infrastructure as distinct from carriageway construction.

The committee presented its report to Parliament on August 11 after hearing from Road Transport Ministry officials, the Bus and Car Oper-

ators Confederation of India, FlixBus, GreenCell Mobility and inter-city operators.

AIRPORT MODEL
It has proposed an Airports Authority-style National Bus Terminals Authority that gives public and private operators common access to bus terminals. Evidence presented to the panel cited Delhi’s Kashmere Gate Interstate Bus Terminal as an example. Private buses pay about ₹500 per entry through FASTag,

with one operator alone contributing roughly ₹5 lakh a day. According to submissions before the committee, smaller terminals opened to private operators became cash-flow positive within months.

SEAMLESS TRAVEL
It also called for a National Bus Digital Grid for passengers to track and book buses, as can be done for trains.

The grid will combine public and private bus tracking, real-time seat availability and booking, passenger ratings and geo-tagged complaints.

“The task is not another portal; it is the grid beneath every portal,” the committee said.

Vahan holds permit and fitness information, FASTag records toll movements and commercial buses carry tracking devices, yet passengers cannot see those services as one national network, it said.

The Minister was briefed by Secretary (Defence Production) Sanjeev Kumar and respective chiefs of the companies on their functioning, key achievements and future roadmap. Minister of State for Defence Sanjay Seth was also present.

sustain production during prolonged conflicts are for any nation,” he said at the day-long meeting here.

Welcoming the increased investment in R&D, he stated that the success of innovation should be measured not just by the amount spent but by the development of new technologies, intellectual property, prototypes and operational products.

QUALITY DRIVE
“We must identify niche technology areas where India can become not just self-reliant, but a global leader,” he added.

He urged the companies to continue focusing on elevating the quality of their products to global standards. “In pursuit of the ‘Make in India, Make for the World’ objective, we must resolve to transform all defence PSUs into global giants,” he said.

Earlier, in his address, Singh said that all the 16 defence PSUs are showing their achievement in multiple sectors and congratulated the organisations for their continued dedication and excellence.

He underlined that in 2025-26, India achieved defence production worth ₹1.8 lakh crore with the defence PSUs contributing ₹1.29 lakh crore.

He termed the achievement a reflection of the nation’s significant progress towards building an *aatmanirbhar* defence industrial base.

DIVIDEND PAYOUT
The CMDs of seven DPSUs resented dividend cheques, worth a total of ₹3,951 crore for FY26.

‘Ports and airports are at the heart of AP’s MSME push’

Andhra Pradesh is betting on an expanded network of ports and airports to drive exports and strengthen its MSME sector, with the State planning a seaport every 150 km and an airport every 200 km along key growth corridors, said Kondapalli Srinivas, Minister for MSME, Society for Elimination of Rural Poverty, NRI Relations & Empowerment, Andhra Pradesh.

The State now has six operational ports and four under construction, taking the total to 10, he said while addressing the 116th annual general

meeting of the Southern India Chamber of Commerce and Industry on Tuesday.

The State is pursuing a similar strategy in aviation connectivity to ensure that businesses have access to an airport within a distance of about 150 to 200 km, he said.

Chamber’s President Arun Alagappan said Prime Minister Narendra Modi had said that when States grow, India grows. “Two States concern us,” he added.

He urged the Minister to host an India-EU FTA conclave in Visakhapatnam, conduct MSME financial clinics across key cities and lead an MSME business delegation to high-potential markets.

Sumadhura enters Chennai with ₹400-cr logistics park

Sumadhura, the Bengaluru-based real estate group, has entered Chennai with a Grade A built-to-suit industrial and logistics park in Red Hills in north Chennai. Backed by an investment of ₹400 crore, the project is spread across 52 acres.

It will offer 1.2 million sq ft of warehousing space, generate around 2,500 jobs and is targeted for completion by December 2028, said a release.
