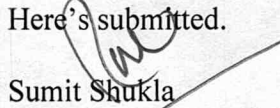

CM Yogi pays tribute to MLA's wife

Gorakhpur: Chief minister Yogi Adityanath on Monday visited the residence of Sitwa MLA Prem Sagar Patel in Pipra Babu village to pay tribute to his wife, Bindrawati Devi. Devi passed away after the UP cabinet approved the transfer of land for the project near the autonomous state medical college in the district.

Ganga e-way built without bank loans, says CM Yogi

Cites UP's Stronger Finances

Lucknow: Chief minister Yogi Adityanath on Monday said the nearly 600-km-long Ganga Expressway has been built without taking loans from banks, presenting it as a sign of the state's improved financial strength and administrative discipline.

Addressing a programme at Lok Bhawan during the distribution of appointment letters to newly selected auditors, the chief minister said more than Rs 36,000 crore has been spent on the expressway, while the total expenditure, including industrial clusters and logistics hubs being developed along the corridor, has crossed Rs 42,000 crore.

He said the industrial and logistics hubs are being developed along the expressway and around 7,000 acres of additional land have been acquired for them. According to him, Uttar Pradesh now has the capacity to complete large infrastructure projects using its own resources.

"Before 2017, this was not the situation. The state was considered BIMARL and no bank or financial institution was willing to give loans. But now Uttar Pradesh is a revenue-surplus state," Adityanath said.

The chief minister said that when his government took office in 2017, the state treasury was under severe strain and financial institutions were reluctant to lend to Uttar Pradesh. He said the government then chose to focus on increasing internal resources, enforcing financial discipline and improving financial management instead of depending on borrowings.

He said this approach helped the state avoid burdening people with excessive debt and contributed to strengthening the financial structure of the government. He credited the success to the discipline along with local and panchayat audit teams for functioning as an internal support system in this process.

Adityanath said that although banks and financial institutions later showed interest in funding the Ganga Expressway, the government decided to proceed without external borrowing. He also claimed that the state has reduced loans taken by previous governments.

The chief minister said Uttar Pradesh is now among the top three state economies in the country whereas earlier it was counted among the bottom three. He added that the state became revenue surplus and succeeded in tripling its economy per capita income and budget.

Adityanath also cited the Jayaprakash Narayan International Centre (JPNIC) project in Lucknow as an example of financial discipline before 2017. He said the project began with an estimated cost of Rs 200 crore, which later rose to Rs 800 crore, but remains incomplete. He described it as a misuse of public money and said it was an insult to the legacy of Jayaprakash Narayan.

The chief minister further said the state's revenue has risen sharply over the years. According to him, Uttar Pradesh earned around Rs 12,000 crore from excise before 2017, while the figure has now increased to about Rs 62,000 crore from Rs 63,000 crore after excise duties were plugged. He said these leakages were caused by misuse within the system rather than technical issues.

At the event, Adityanath distributed appointment letters to 371 newly selected auditors for the Cooperative Societies and Panchayat Audit Department and 129 auditors for the Local Panchayat Audit Department. He said internal audit plays a crucial role in ensuring financial discipline in village panchayats, municipalities and district-level institutions, which he described as the foundation of development.

He also said the recruitment process was transparent and merit-based, with no appointments made through recommendations. Referring to earlier years, he alleged that paper leaks, nepotism and irregularities in recruitment were common before 2017, often resulting in disputes and court cases that harmed young aspirants.

The current system ensures equal opportunity for all, regardless of religion, caste or region, and selection is based purely on merit. The government follows a policy of zero tolerance towards crime and corruption," he said.

Highlighting women's participation, the chief minister said 78 women were among the 371 selected candidates in cooperative and panchayat audit, while 25 women were among the 129 selected in local fund audit.

He added that more than 9 lakh jobs have been provided so far and that appointments are being distributed regularly. He also said government policies have generated employment for around 3 crore people in the MSME sector, while schemes such as Drone Didi, Lakshmi Didi, IC Sakhi, dairy initiatives, PM Startup, PM Stand-Up and the Chief Minister's Youth Entrepreneur Scheme are helping youth and women access livelihood opportunities.

Yogi's campaign helped the BJP win 10 of 13 seats held by the TMC. Only Dhankhal, Udayanagar and Bulpur remained with the TMC.

Yogi was among the most sought-after leaders in the high-stakes West Bengal polls, where the BJP was locked in a direct contest with the Mamata Banerjee-led TMC.

A high point of Yogi's rallies came on April 13 when BJP's favourite Adhikari touched the feet of the UP chief minister at a public rally in Kanthi Dakshin Assembly

CM to open devpt projects worth ₹612cr in Gkp today

Gorakhpur: Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath will launch 71 development projects worth Rs 62.31 crore in Gorakhpur on Tuesday.

According to officials, the CM will inaugurate 26 ready projects and lay foundation stones for 45 others.

"The CM will inaugurate a convention centre (Kalyan Mandapam) at Jungle Beni Madhau and a newly built two-lane bridge over a water body in Taramandal area. He will also lay foundation stone for several major urban infrastructure projects being developed by the Gorakhpur Development Authority (GDA)," said an official.

The two-lane bridge, constructed at a cost of Rs 14.33 crore between Vasundhara Enclave Phase-II and III, is expected to significantly improve connectivity across the fast-growing Taramandal residential belt. The 138-metre-long bridge includes 15-metre-wide foot-

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
