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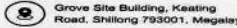
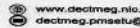
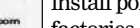

GSMC alleges Assam census staff coercing Meghalaya residents in border villages

Shillong, Sep 10: The Garoland State Movement Committee (GSMC), Pedaldoba Regional Unit, has petitioned the Deputy Commissioner of West Garo Hills, alleging coercive enrolment of Meghalaya residents in Assam census in border villages.

Chairman Rimjen Ch. Sangma, in a letter today, alleged that census officials from Goalpara entered villages like Ku'rung and Saltopgre under Raksamgre

Civil Sub-Division around 11 am on Wednesday and intimidated residents to register in Assam.

He said the residents are long-time citizens of Meghalaya since statehood with voter IDs, ration cards and Aadhaar linked to Meghalaya and availing benefits from the state government. He claimed officials threatened denial of government benefits if they resisted.

Sangma said villages like Saltopgre, Kurung, Pedaldoba

and Rongsai lie in disputed territory but remain administratively under Meghalaya, with Jinjiram River as natural boundary, and warned that double registration could lead to loss of Meghalaya citizenship, ST status and voting rights.

He urged the DC to defend rights of Meghalaya citizens, issue a directive against coercive Assam enrolment, deploy District Census Officer or Border Magistrate for verification, and take up the matter with Goalpara DC.

CM inaugurates block office at Rongara in South Garo Hills

“This is not merely a book release but an occasion to honour a statesman whose public life was linked with the aspirations, identity and rights of the people of Meghalaya,” Sangma said.

Recalling his legacy, the Speaker said Lyngdoh was regarded as the father of coalition politics in Meghalaya, whose ability to build consensus showed that dialogue could strengthen democracy.



Sangma noted that Lyngdoh served as Chief Minister four times and his vision went beyond politics to issues of land, livelihood, development and social harmony. He highlighted Lyngdoh's advocacy for cadastral surveys and his role in introducing the Local Area Development Scheme, now

known as the MLA scheme. Author Dr. Andrew Simons said Lyngdoh was among the leaders who fought for statehood and shaped the state's political institutions. He said the book, which took nearly three years to complete, covers Lyngdoh's political career from 1970 till his death in 2003.

introduction of a 'guidebook' by the government. In addition, the PGI national ranking of the state has also improved, though from a low base. However, the government has faced protests from teachers over pay, the latest of which revolves around the structure pay framework and the payscale for new teachers.

State boasts largest community

community meetings, pass resolutions to restrict tobacco sale near schools, issue no-smoking orders for public places, install anti-tobacco signage, posters and conduct community awareness drives.

These actions are documented and verified and a VHC is recognised as tobacco-free after successfully completing and verifying at least five of the six prescribed activities. During the first year, senior officials from the Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and World Health Organisation (WHO) visited participating villages and commended the community-driven model.

The initiative has been seeing visible impacts on the ground. The VHC chairperson of Mawmluh

VHC in Shella block shared that around 40-50 per cent of villagers have stopped smoking or using tobacco in public places such as tea shops, bus stands and social gatherings, while about 60-70 per cent have stopped smoking inside their homes, particularly around infants and young children.

The third year of the TVF Programme began on September 1. In just two years a state known with nearly 50 per cent of its population being tobacco users is turning its villages into the frontline of the fight against it, the release said. “Community by community, home by home, Meghalaya is proving that tobacco-free living is not a distant goal but a reality being built right now - and setting the benchmark for the rest of India to follow.”
